Special Features

It doesn't seem to matter how often we paint the little gate, sooner or later a green gunge appears on it. Scraping it off is a tiresome chore which has to be done before painting again.

When asked however to test an answer that was just sprayed on, how could I refuse? Spray it on, no need to scrub, and leave it for 48 hours – it all seemed far too easy.

Green Clean can be used from a one-litre spray bottle or larger containers for garden

spraying equipment. One litre covers 12 to 15 square metres. It must be dry when applying, and if a white residue appears, all you have to do is wash it with water. The treatment lasts up to a year, but only for six months if areas are shady or damp.

It removes lichens, algae, moss and mould from wood, stone, concrete and most other surfaces. It is organic and environmentally friendly to wildlife, but take care near garden ponds.

VERDICT

Having tried other solutions that failed, I was amazed that it actually worked, particularly as it rained almost non-stop for the 48 hours after spraying it on. The only drawback is we now have one gate which is lovely and clean, showing up the big gate next to it covered in horrid green gunge!
